

VetXML Marketing Guidelines.

VetXML has been designed to enable the accurate monitoring and sharing of veterinary information and, as such, we are keen to propagate its use in all areas of veterinary data exchange.

We ask that all members and non-members that make use of VetXML schema, take every opportunity to promote VetXML in marketing materials associated with the VetXML powered functionality. Similarly, we request that all members make use of the VetXML Member logo to publicised their affiliation with the Consortium.

It is very important that VetXML and the Consortium are appropriately and consistently recognised in products using the data format, and in any published work (whether online or printed). We therefore suggest the following use of the VetXML logos and brand:





Scaling

Either of the VetXML logos may be scaled to any size, as long as the minimum size requirements are upheld. If the logo is displayed as smaller than the minimum size requirements, clarity and definition will be lost.
